Number: PPD - 0608 Subject: Visiting Students

The active presence of visiting students can be beneficial both to VIMS and to the visitors. VIMS encourages and supports such activity as long as space and facilities are available. Most visits are for a year or less.

A faculty member seeking to host a visiting student must obtain permission of the Department Chair, who is responsible for the allocation of space and other resources, and from the Associate Dean of Academic Studies who will maintain records of visiting students. The Application for Visiting Student Status form is appended to this document. The host is responsible for guiding the visiting student through the initial introduction to the Institute's personnel and structure.

Visiting students are required to sign a <u>Liability Release Form</u>, go through a sign-in procedure that includes basic safety and right-to-know training, and complete the Volunteer/Visiting Scientist <u>Check-in/out Sheet</u>. The host must make appropriate arrangements for the student's computer and networking needs with the Information Technology and Network Services (<u>ITNS</u>). Further arrangements will need to be made for appropriate identification, library sign-out permission, and office access and keys, among other things. Prior to departure from VIMS, a visiting student must submit a completed Volunteer/Visiting Scientist Check in/out Sheet.

The host of an international student should seek guidance from the <u>Reves Center</u> regarding appropriate visa and immigration documents. This should be started well in advance, at a minimum, three to six months prior to the anticipated arrival of a visiting student.

A visiting student is not admitted to the School of Marine Science or any other William & Mary academic program. Visiting Student status may be terminated at any time and for any reason by the Associate Dean of Academic Studies. Visiting students are not paid employees of the Virginia Institute of Marine Science (VIMS) or William & Mary (W&M).
